- 16-week Undergraduate Summer Student Research Awards for full time students who have completed at least the first year of university study of an undergraduate degree
- Two-year Master's Student Research Awards for full time students in the first year of an eligible Master's program

Deadline for the awards is January 18, 2010. Please check with your university regarding other important deadlines. Applications must be submitted to the university you are attending.
