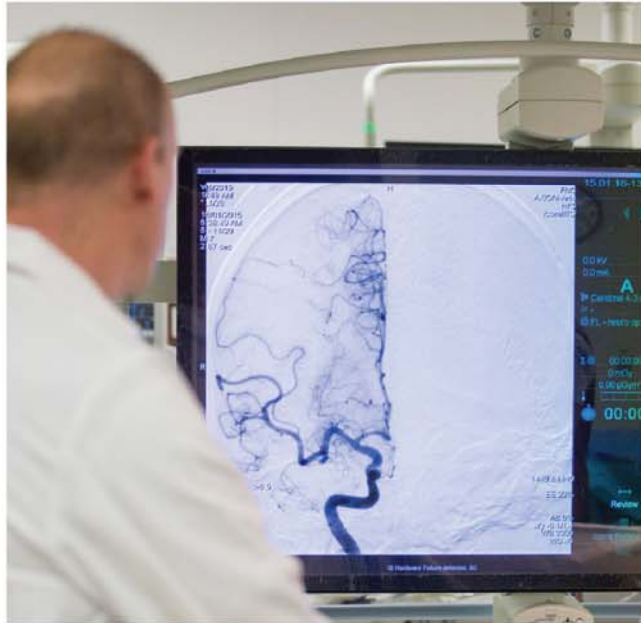


# ENDOVASCULAR STROKE TREATMENT IS THE NEW STANDARD OF CARE!
